MINUTES

The regular January meeting of the Village of Ellenville Historic Preservation Commission was called to order at 5:34 p.m. in the 4th floor meeting room of the Government Center by Chair Marion M. Dumond.

Minutes of the January 19, 2011 meeting were approved by Commissioners.

Website Updates –The Commission is to work with Noreen Dechon to make revisions to the Commission’s web page. (Ross/Draganchuk will conference prior to March meeting) Additions to the website will include: Commissioner biographies, the 2010 Reconnaissance Level Historic Resource Survey, a COA the bylaws, and an application for membership.

The final draft of the historic districts must be edited by as soon as possible. All commissioners will review and send corrections to Jill Fisher by Monday, February 21, 2011. Mentioned at the meeting were several specific items to look into including: P. Ross to review grammar, M. Dumond to contact Mary Bury regarding the United Methodist Church, and the need for clarification on 77 Main Street being zoned as one business and two residences.

Copies of the 2010 Reconnaissance Level Historic Research Survey has been assembled and distributed to each HPC Commissioner, the Village Manager, the Village Board, the Village Clerk, Brian Schug and the Ellenville Public Library and Museum.

M. Dumond to contact Bill Krattinger and invite him to the March 16, 2011 meeting to discuss plans for introducing and informing the community about the historic district. If this date is not available for B. Krattinger to meet with the HPC, a special meeting date will be scheduled in March to explore this item.
