Nika Curanovic – 55 Center Street – Special use permit and site plan application to create a four unit apartment building – continued discussion.

Thomas Kentop was before the board tonight to represent Mr. Curanovic and reviewed the site plan with the Planning Board. Board members requested to have the flood lighting with specifications on the plan as well as the landscaping. There was discussion among board members in reference to the apartments and the commissioners will do a site visit on June 22nd at 11:00 a.m. Also discussed was to relocate the front office entry to include a 3' x 3' landing leading to the staircase.

Motion by Commissioner Maizer, seconded by Commissioner Zelnik to have the following added to the site plan before the next review:

1. Flood lighting with specifications on the lighting
2. Relocation of front office entry to include a 3' x 3' landing leading to the staircase.
