New York Rising Community Reconstruction Application Available for Review

The Village of Ellenville intends to submit an application for New York State Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program funds on or about February 21, 2017 for the *Ellenville Shelter and Community Center* project.

Activity: New York State CDBG-DR funds will be used to pay for the needs assessment, site location, acquisition, and construction and/or rehabilitation of an emergency shelter and community center within the Village of Ellenville which will serve in non-emergency times as a community center.

..... Objective: This project will mitigate the need for residents of Ellenville and the Town of Wawarsing to seek shelter during times of severe weather events and catastrophes outside of their immediate community as what was experienced during Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee.

Location: Within the Village of Ellenville, Ulster County, New York. The intended target area would be the commercial downtown core of the Village.

Amount: \$1,200,000.00 CDBG-DR funds.
